FACILITY

\$35/day/person in dorms

\$40/day/person in apartment (max capacity 6; available August – December)

\$250/week/person in apartment (available August – December)

STAFF

Do you need weekly or monthly data collections or observations on the same site over a period of time, but you can't break away to do it? Our marine science staff members know where to go and have the experience necessary to provide you with accurate, reliable data. They are trained in a variety of survey techniques.

Project support (no diving): \$50/hour plus fuel, minimum of two hours.

SCUBA support: \$75/hour plus fuel, minimum of three hours.

Collection equipment on hand includes but is not limited to: YSI Meter with sonde (DO, pH, salinity, temperature), LaMotte H2O sampler, 50 m transects, ½ m² quadrats, sediment corer, refractometer, plankton nets, phytoplankton net, seine nets, camera with underwater housing, turbidity meter, SWIFT M10 Digital Microscopes with LCD screen and monocular head (1000X). Researcher must provide sample bottles or units and cover any shipping costs.

VESSELS

MV HALI – 26' Twin Vee catamaran. Provides stable platform for collecting, snorkeling, or SCUBA diving. Operator provided, max 6 passengers plus captain. Can accommodate up to 5 divers (4 divers if doing two tank dives). Operator must stay on boat, cannot provide in water assistance.

Half day (approximately 4 hours) \$200 plus fuel

Full day \$375 plus fuel

Additional staff (in water dive guide, assistant): \$25/hour
